2. The applicant is not an individual or organization in Japan recognized as antisocial forces under Article 2, Paragraph 2, Subparagraph 1 of the Japan Foundation's Regulations with Regard to Dealing with Anti-Social Forces (Regulations no. 52 of FY 2015).
3. I/we do not engage in activities intended to promote any specific ideology, doctrine, or policy or to propagate any religion or similar ideology, activities counter to the public interest, or other activities or projects counter to the intentions of Japonismes 2018.
4. I/we consent to inclusion in the official website of Japonismes 2018 and related materials, such as promotional materials, printed materials, and reports, as a project implemented as part of Japonismes 2018.
5. I/we shall display the Japonismes 2018 logo in the program’s promotional materials, printed materials, etc. In using the logo, I/we shall comply with the logo usage guidelines.
6. I/we shall not use or reproduce the logo in connection with any projects other than those for which it is authorized.
7. I/we shall submit a project report to the Secretariat for JAPONISMES by post within two months after the completion of the project.
8. I/we shall notify the Secretariat for JAPONISMES promptly in the event of any change in the content of the project or cancellation of the project.
